Use digital conferencing platforms to meet with your group.

Zoom

By signing up for a free account, Zoom users are allowed to host free video meetings up to 40 minutes on a desktop or mobile device. Additional time requires a paid plan.

Google Hangouts

Requires all participants to have a Google account. Each Hangout allows up to 10 people per phone call for an unlimited amount of time via the web browser or Google Hangout app.

Focus on connection and prayer in your meetings.

Your group members will need connection and prayer more than anything during this time. Make **welcoming one another (Rom. 15:17)** and **loving one another (John 15:17)** the priority of your meetings.
